Hearing Screening Clinics for Reception Children



Did you know your child is entitled to a free hearing test whilst they are in reception class? Here are signs that may indicate hearing difficulties:

- Not responding when called
- Speaking very loudly
- Frequently asking for repetitions or responding inappropriately
- Increasing volume on devices
- Appearing to daydream
- Slow to learn or unclear speech
- Frequent frustration or aggression

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

Tablets remain a staple of children's digital lives – and Apple's iPad is by far the most popular model. According to Ofcom, over half of younger children regularly use a tablet to play games, watch online content or access apps. With their broad functionality, iPads can be helpful tools, but without supervision, they may expose children to risks ranging from inappropriate content to screen overuse.

COSTLY TO REPAIR

Tablets come with sturdy frames. The iPad is no exception, but the design is so high-tech that there's a lot of stuff packed into a thin tablet. It's not surprising, it's why the cost of repairs is so high. You'll need to get the device repaired at a specialist repair shop or Apple. Repairs can be quite expensive, so it's worth considering a case to protect your tablet's investment.

DATA PRIVACY

While Apple is known for strong privacy protection, a 2016 study found that many iOS apps know a lot about their users' personal data. Over 200 of the most popular apps had at least one piece of user information in their personal data. This includes things like location, contact lists, and more. ENABLE FAMILY SHARING

Family Sharing allows you to create a dedicated Apple ID for your child and manage their device. You can approve purchases, control what content they can access, and set time limits – all done remotely from your own device. It's a simple but powerful way to maintain oversight.

FILTER APPS, WEBSITES & IN-APP PURCHASES

Screen Time allows you to filter out explicit content, restrict app downloads, and manage in-app purchase permissions. You can also use parental controls to prevent access to adult material and disable the installation of certain apps from the App Store.

USE SCREEN TIME FEATURES EFFECTIVELY

Use the downtime and app limits to reduce device use. Screen Time allows you to block access during key times – such as before bed or during homework – while app limits can help you set limits on specific games or apps. PREVENT UNAPPROVED SPENDING

Children can accidentally (or intentionally) make purchases with apps. Enabling Ask to Buy under Family Sharing ensures you receive notification to approve any app or in-app purchase.
