

Starting Primary School in September 2023

Children born between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019 can start school in September 2023. For more information about school admissions and to apply online at www.coventry.gov.uk/admissions. Telephone 02476 831622/1613. Closing date for applications is 15th January 2023.

Please note: If you wish to apply to a Catholic school and your child is baptised Catholic <u>evidence of your child's baptism must be provided at the time of application</u> to the school office or to the Admissions Team. It is your responsibility to obtain and present this evidence.

Starting Nursery School in September 2023

Application forms and information are available from the school office for parents wishing to apply for their child to start in Nursery in September 2023. Children born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020 can start Nursery in September 2023.

Closing date for applications is 15th January 2023.

Please note: If you wish to apply to a Catholic school and your child is baptised Catholic <u>evidence of your child's baptism must be provided at the time of application</u> to the school office. It is your responsibility to obtain and present this evidence.
