What Parents & Carers Need to Know about Money muling involves individuals — very frequently young people — being recruited to transfer illegally obtained funds into and out of their bank account on behalf of criminals (often without even realising that's the kind of activity they ve become embroiled in), and usually being allowed to keep a certain amount for themselves. It's essentially a digital form of money laundering. 
