Take Home Tasks Year 5 World War I

Our take home tasks this term are focusing on the arts.

Please complete at least one of the following take home tasks and bring this into school before 24th November.

Remember it's okay to work with your family members to create your take home task.

As Performers

Write a poem about something linked to World War I. Use your senses to help with your ideas of what you might hear, see, smell, feel if you were a solider during this time.

You could record this and email it into school to share with your class, or you could rehearse at home and then perform it to your class.

As Artists

Draw the silhouette of a solider and decorate the background.

OR

Create an individual poppy using recycled materials you may have at home.

As Creative Writers

Write a diary entry.

Think about who you want to write as e.g. Soldier, officer, wife or children at home.

OR

Write a letter- this could be as a soldier to home or from home to a soldier.

As Musicians

Listen to a song written around the time of the First World War. Search for 'Pack up your troubles', 'Keep the Home Fires Burning' or Gustav Holst 'The Planets Suite: Mars or 'Jupiter'.

Write down how you feel when you listen to them. Be ready to discuss with your class.
