



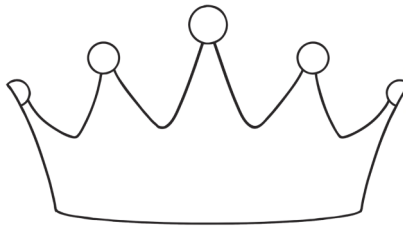
**A Tribute to the Legacy of Queen Elizabeth II**

With adult support, children will be given a fact about the Queen and asked to draw something related to that statement.

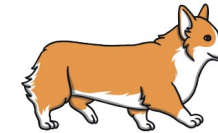
For example; Her Majesty supported the The Royal Canadian Air Force Reserve. Can you draw an aeroplane?
