Please do let me know if you have any questions, queries or concerns relating to the homework.

Reading

We encourage a love for reading and aim to hear each child read at least once a week. We ask for your support in reading with your child daily. Reading is a vital component for progress across the Curriculum.

Children will be sent home with new books on a **Tuesday** and/or **Friday**, these are also the days that the children must return their books and reading records to school.

I would appreciate it if you could record the pages that your child has read, and any comments that you have in your child's Reading Record.

We also encourage the children to read a variety of genres and literature, and not just their school reading book, in order to broaden their understanding and vocabulary. At the moment, we are reading 'The Last Bear' by Hannah Gold, the children are really enjoying it!
