

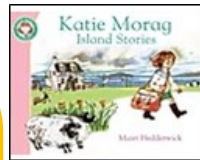
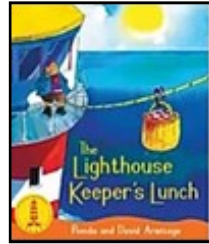

Writing Outcomes: Diary Entry, Postcards, Fact File, Instruction Writing.

English Skills: Punctuation, Comprehension, Guided Reading and Writing, Grammar, Spelling, Handwriting.

Read as much as possible with and to your child and encourage them to discuss what they have read.

Questioning them on what they have read will help to develop their understanding of the text on a deeper level - How do you know? Why do you think this? Which word/words tell you this?

Read to your child!

Use these question stems to support reading at home.

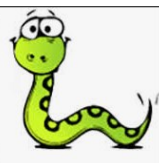

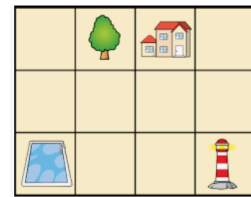

This could help:

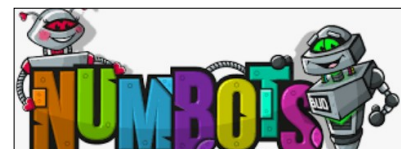
- ◆ Addition and Subtraction

Encourage your child to use their number skills in everyday situations. Ask them to add and subtract simple amounts. Solve simple money problems. For example, finding change in a shop, finding the total of items in your shopping basket, dividing sweets into equal groups. Help them to recognise the value of real coins.

SHARING JESUS' LIFE

To know the stories of the call of the disciples and some information about them. To know and be able to recall some stories about Jesus and his disciples, which show that the disciples shared in the life and work of Jesus. The children will be able to identify some characteristics of a disciple and describe some ways in which Jesus changes or affects people's lives.

JESUS: TEACHER AND HEALER

To understand that Jesus taught people about God and how they should live through stories called parables, and that he performed miracles that healed people. To know some of the parables that Jesus told and will be able to explain what he is teaching us through them. To know that Jesus performed miracles that healed people. To know that Christians are called to follow this example of care today.



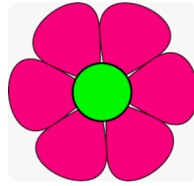
Attend Mass every week and talk about the Liturgy and the Gospel.

Encourage your child to talk about the kind of person God intends them to be and how this can be seen through their actions.

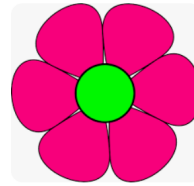
Set aside special time every day to pray together as a family.

Have a special place in your home dedicated to God.

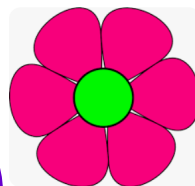

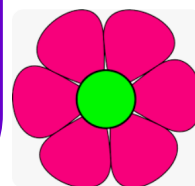

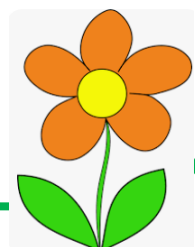

- ◆ How have seaside resorts changed over time?



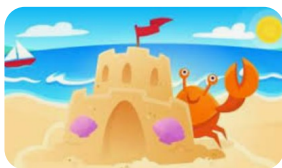
Discuss with your child:
