- Enabling your child to learn their phonics words through reading and spelling
- Practise writing letters and words to develop their handwriting.



At home, you can help by: Encourage your child to use their number skills in everyday situations. Ask them to count, add and subtract in fun ways.

Practise number bonds to 10 and 20. Count in jumps of 2, 3, 5 and 10!

You could: - Find the odd and even numbers on your street .

Split amounts into parts and wholes

- Share sweets into equal groups

- Count coloured cars on the road Encourage your child to use their mental calculations.

Encourage your child to look at the shape of real world objects and use the correct mathematical terms to describe them.

This half term, our Religious Education will focus

The children will find out about:

- Develop the children's understanding of prayer as a special way of spending time with God. The children will explore how Christians give praise to God in the psalms and in prayers like the "Glory Be To The Father" and the "Our Father".
- develop the children's understanding of Advent as a time of waiting and preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus and his coming again. The unit also develops the children's understanding of Advent as a joyful liturgical season and allows them to participate in a special liturgy.

Talking to the children about their learning and supporting them with science vocabulary such as carnivores, herbivores and omnivores, and touch, taste, smell, sight and sound.

- Use compass points—NORTH, EAST, SOUTH, WEST—Never Eat Slimy Worms.




