

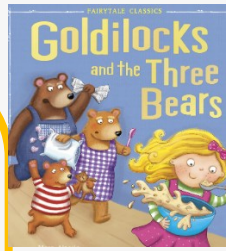
TOY STORY

- Practise writing letters and words to develop their handwriting.

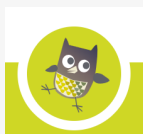

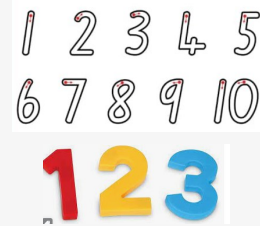


**This could

Mathematics

The children will study the following:

- Numbers to 10.
- Part -whole numbers within 10.
- Fewer or more within numbers 10.



Encourage your child to use their number skills in everyday situations. Ask them to count, add and subtract in fun ways.

Practise number bonds to 10. Count forwards and backwards from 10.

You could: Use the link for some extra games that support counting to 10.

Science

This half term the children will study ...

The children will:

- In science, children will look at seasonal changes that happen in Autumn and Winter. They will describe the changes that happen to trees, weather and the temperature around them.
- They also learn how the different types of weather can be measure in the season of Autumn through various investigations.
- Forest School is a child-centred inspirational learning process, that offers opportunities for holistic growth through regular sessions.

- Ask the children to discuss the different changes that are happening as Autumn starts to become Winter. Talk about what you might have to wear in the different types of weathers.
- Ask children to collect the different type of materials found in Autumn e.g. different coloured leaves, acorns and pinecones and make an Autumn collage.

1. How can we find out about the past?
2. What are our toys like now?
3. What was my favourite toy when I was a baby?
4. What were toys like in the past and how do we know?
5. How have children's toys changed since our parents and grandparents were children?

- Discuss Children's current toys – What are they made from?
- You could tell the children about what toys were like when you were young or what they were like when their grandparents were young.
- Ask children to describe their toys to you.
